SCOUTING THE GOLDEN GOPHERS: No. 4/4 Minnesota enters this weekend's matchup with New Hampshire as one of just six undefeated Division I programs. The Gophers are 4-0-2 overall and will step away from WCHA play for the first time this season. Minnesota's 10 points in WCHA gives it a three-point cushion over Colorado College, which is ranked first in the latest national poll. A well-rounded team, the Gophers rank 13th nationally in scoring (3.5 gpg) and 17th defensively (2.17 gpg). Led by head coach Don Lucia, who is one of five active coaches with more than 500 victories, Minnesota was picked fourth in the preseason WCHA Coaches' Poll behind CC, North Dakota and Denver. Offensively, the Gophers are led by Ryan Stoa, who has 10 points (6-4-10) in six games (1.67 ppg). Between the pipes, Minnesota is led by Alex Kangas, who is allowing just over two goals per game (2.11 GAA) and has a .922 save percentage.

SERIES HISTORY VS. MINNESOTA: UNH trails the all-time series with Minnesota 2-12-1 in 15 meetings dating back to March 23, 1979... The two last met Dec. 21, 2003 at the Dodge Classic at Mariucci Arena... Minnesota won that game 4-2... The Wildcats and Gophers have met three times in NCAA tournament, including an April 12, 2003 meeting in the NCAA National Championship game at HSBC Arena, a 5-1 Minnesota win. None of the players on the current roster were on the team for the 2003 meetings... Coach Umile has a 1-3-11 record against Minnesota, while the 'Cats are 0-1-0 lifetime against Minnesota at Mariucci Arena, but do have a pair of wins (Harvard and Miami) at both as participants in the Dodge Classic in 1995 and 2003.

FOSTER NAMED ITECH HOCKEY EAST GOALIE OF THE MONTH:

Brian Foster was ITECH Hockey East Goalie of the Month for October. Foster becomes the first Wildcat netminder to win this award since Kevin Regan in February 2008. Foster played all six games in the month and went 4-1-1 with wins over three nationally ranked

teams. He stopped 30-plus shots on four occasions and allowed two goals or fewer in five out of six starts. He totaled a season-high 38 saves in a 1-1 tie against UMass and recorded a shutout of Rensselaer on Oct. 27.

GENEROUS MOSES SETS CAREER HIGH: Steve Moses registered a pair of assists in the Wildcats' 2-2 tie at Northeastern. The two points were a career-high for the freshman forward.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW DIGIROLAMO: Freshman netminder Matt DiGirolamo got his first start on Saturday night at Northeastern and stopped 22 shots including four in overtime to preserve a 2-2 tie with the Huskies.

UNBEATEN THROUGH FOUR HOCKEY EAST GAMES: UNH remained unbeaten in Hockey East play (2-0-2) through four games for the first time since 2003-04.

UNH CONTINUES SUCCESS AT MATTHEWS ARENA: The Wildcats are 7-0-2 in their last nine games at Matthews Arena.

GREAT STARTS: UNH's 5-1-2 start is its best start since the 2003-04 season when it was 6-1-0 out of the gate.

BUTLER CATCHING FIRE: Bobby Butler scored three points over the last two games after having only one point in his first five games.

RAPID FIRE: UNH's 45 shots on net was the most its had since 49 shots in its triple-overtime loss to BC in last year's Hockey East semifinals.

KESSEL CONNECTION: UNH freshman defender Blake Kessel's brother, Phil Kessel, played for the Gophers during the 2005-06 season. Phil had 51 points in his lone season with Minnesota before leaving to pursue an NHL career with the Boston Bruins. Kessel was the WCHA Rookie of the Year and led the Gophers to a WCHA regular season championship.

A PAIR OF COACHING LEGENDS: Don Lucia and Dick Umile have secured their places in hockey history, ranking in the top ten in wins and winning percentage among active coaches.

HOME SWEET HOME: UNH is in its 14th season of play at the Whittemore Center in 2008-09, posting a 4-0-1 at Towse Rink... UNH owns a 174-48-20 all-time record in 14 seasons of play at the Whittemore Center with 158 sellouts during that time in 241 all-time games.

THE DICK UMILE ERA: Dick Umile, a five-time Hockey East Coach of the Year, enters his 19th season as the head coach of the UNH Wildcats. He recently earned his fourth Leonard Fowle New England Coach of the Year award. After signing a long-term contract in 2000, Umile will conclude his coaching career at his alma mater. During his time spent at UNH, Umile has molded UNH hockey into one of the top programs in all of Division I hockey, guiding the Wildcats to four Frozen Four appearances, 14 NCAA tournament appearances and 18 Hockey East championship tournament showings in his 18-year career in Durham. In addition, Umile has posted 16 20-victory campaigns over the span of 18 seasons, including a current streak of 12 20-win seasons and back-to-back 25-plus win seasons. Umile is now the winningest coach in the history of UNH hockey with 424 career victories. He surpassed legendary coach Charlie Holt on Feb. 16, 2005 in a 6-1 victory at Merrimack at Thom Lawler Arena in North Andover, Mass. Umile

ranks third among active NCAA coaches with a .653 winning percentage and on the active victories list his 424 victories ranks eighth among NCAA coaches. He has been named Coach of the Year a total of 10 times in his career, including New England honors four times. Umile's five Hockey East Coach of the Year Awards is an all-time league best. Last season Umile led the Wildcats to a 25-10-3 record, including a program-record 19 Hockey East wins en route to a 19-5-3 record in league play, which earned UNH the regular season title for the second season in a row. Umile captured his 400th career victory Oct. 19, 2007 against Boston University. Umile coached four All-Americans in Kevin Regan, Mike Radja, Matt Fornataro, and Brad Flashains, which was the first time in school history that four players received that honor.

THE PROGRAM'S HISTORY: UNH has appeared in the NCAA Tournament 18 times in the 81-year history of the program. UNH has appeared in the Frozen Four seven times, including national championship game appearances against Maine in 1999 and Minnesota in 2003. UNH earned Hockey East Tournament titles in 2002 and 2003 and regular-season championships in 1997, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2007 and 2008.
